USPAACC Denny's Hungry for Education High School Scholarship Currently enrolled high school students in the United States or Puerto Rico and all applicants must be enrolled in an accredited educational institution (high school). **Award:** \$3,000. **Deadline: March 2**

Phillips 66 Community STEM Scholarship Program Be high school seniors, plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year, pursuing a degree or certification in STEM, and be interested in a career in oil and gas, manufacturing, or chemical industries. **Award:** up to \$5,000 renewable up to 3 years. **Deadline: March 2**

AFA Scholarships Current high school senior or undergraduate student, (age 17-25 during the AFA Leaders Conference*), attending a four-year institution in the US or plans to obtain a four-year degree, 2.5 GPA or higher (recommended), passion for food, agriculture and/or natural resources, and intention to pursue a career in the food, agriculture and/or natural resources industries. **Award:** up to \$3,200. **Deadline: March 5**

Women's Western Golf Foundation Scholarship Woman high school senior and meet the following requirements: Active participant in the sport of golf (golf ability is not a criterion for selection) and have a 3.5 GPA or above. **Award:** \$20,000 (paid over 4 years)

Create-A-Greeting-Card Scholarship Contest 14 years or older, high school students, college students, graduate students. **Award:** \$10,000. **Deadline: March 9**

Horatio Alger National Scholarships (105 awards) For high school juniors with strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree. **Award:** \$25,000

Go Skills "Be the Boss" Scholarship Female high-school or college student, who wants to start her own business. **Award:** \$2,000. **Deadline: March 15**

American Society of Mechanical Engineers Scholarships Graduating High School (HS) seniors interested in pursuing engineering degrees. Students must be enrolled full-time in an ABET- accredited* or substantially equivalent** mechanical engineering or mechanical engineering technology program, no later than the fall after their senior year in high school.

Award: up to \$5,000. **Deadline: March 15**

Microsoft Disability Scholarship Current high school senior living with a disability including visual, hearing, mobility, cognitive, and/or speech disabilities or other disability.

Award: \$5,000. **Deadline: March 16**

Blacks at Microsoft Scholarship (55 awards) High school senior of African descent (for example, African American, African, Ethiopian, etc.) and plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study in Engineering, Computer Science, Computer Information Systems, or one of the following Business programs – Business Administration, Finance, or Marketing
Award: \$5,000 (5 awards) renewable up to 3 years. \$2,500 (50 awards) not renewable, one-time only. **Deadline: March 16**

Women at Microsoft Scholarship Program Be a graduating high school senior, plan to enroll full-time in a technology, engineering, math, or computer science related undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school, in the United States, for the entire upcoming academic year, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. **Award:** \$5,000. **Deadline: March 16**

Wells Fargo Stacey Milbern Scholarship Have an identified disability (defined as someone who has, or considers themselves to have, a long-term or recurring issue that impacts one or more major life activity), minimum 3.0 GPA, be a high school senior or graduate or a current postsecondary undergraduate who plans to enroll or who is already enrolled in full-time or half-time (at least 6 credits per term) undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire upcoming academic year. **Award:** up to \$5,000. **Deadline: March 20**

Nicholas Virgilio Haiku and Senryu Competition Any student in grades 7 through 12 enrolled in school as of September 2025 may enter. **Award:** \$250. **Deadline: March 20**

CBC Spouses Education Scholarship Attend (or will attend) an undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree program full-time at an accredited college or university (graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply), Minimum 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale, reside or attend an academic institution in a CBC Member's District. **Award:** Varies. **Deadline: March 27**

CBC Spouses Essay Contest Essay contest is open to high school juniors and seniors (grades 11 and 12) at time of submission of essay, must reside or attend a high school in a district represented by a Congressional Black Caucus Member. **Award:** Varies
Deadline: March 27

CBC Spouses Performing Arts Scholarship Pursuing a career in the performing arts with an eligible major, minimum 2.5 GPA, be preparing to pursue, or currently pursuing, an undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree full-time at an accredited college or university. Current high school seniors are also eligible to apply. **Award: \$2,500. Deadline: March 27**

CBC Spouses Visual Arts Scholarship Be pursuing a career in the visual arts with an eligible major, minimum 2.5 GPA, be preparing to pursue, or currently pursuing, an undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree full-time at an accredited college or university. Graduating high school seniors are also eligible to apply. **Award: \$2,500. Deadline: March 27**

Courageous Persuaders Video Contest High school students (grades 9 - 12) nationwide use their creative talents to enter our scholarship competition. Create a 30-second television commercial promoting safe driving to enter. Middle school classrooms determine the winners. **Award: \$3,000. Deadline: March 30**

Hyeholde and the Barbara K.S. Chime Scholars Students of all ages and pathways including high school seniors students and students at any stage in their undergraduate educational journey and highly encourage students enrolled in or thinking about attending direct workforce programs, such as trade or technical education (CTE), to apply, minimum 2.5 GPA, and must be Pell Grant eligible. **Award: \$5,000 (renewable up to \$20,000). Deadline: March 31**

Regions Riding Forward® Scholarship Contest (4 awards) High school juniors, seniors and current college students living in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Illinois,

Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas. **Award:** \$8,000. **Deadline:** March 31

Goya Foods Culinary Arts Scholarship Program Must be entering an accredited two-year or four-year institution as freshmen and majoring in a full-time Culinary Arts or Food Sciences* program for the 2026-27 academic year. Students enrolling in a two-year junior or community college must plan to transfer to a four-year institution to earn a bachelor's degree and to receive the total maximum scholarship award of \$20,000. Have a minimum 3.0 GPA. **Award:** \$5,000 **Deadline:** March 31

1,000 Dreams Fund Scholarship Women currently enrolled in high school, a two-year or four-year college/university, or graduate school in the United States. **Award:** up to \$1,000 **Deadline:** March 31

Because College Is Expensive Open to high school sophomores and above, college students, and graduate school students. **Award:** \$500. **Deadline:** March 31
